

Costa Farms in Pipersville PA USA Grow with Aqua-Hort

The Costa Farms in Pensylvania has used Aqua-Hort since the Autumn of 2008.

The nursery has 10 acre under glass, and 4 acre with benches uncovered. The crops are typical pot plants with bedding plants in the spring, followed by garden mums and Pointsettias later in the year.

The Aqua-Hort is installed on the pipe feeding the day tank. Consequently is the EC low. For that reason is a plate model used, which provides for a large electrode surface.

The outcome of installing the unit is very positive. Head Grower Kevin Echevarria (<u>kechevarria@costafarms.com</u>) informs that the benefits he can notice are:

Better root growth. The Pythium problems have been reduced to a minimum level.

Algea on benches, floors and pot tops disappeared. This has removed the problems with Fungus Gnats and Shore Flies.

The consumption of fungicides is reduced to a mere trickle. This gives economic benefits and less pressure on the environment.
